For faces that will beam.***


***The smell of caramel apples

Faye Peck’s Peach Dessert

Crust

1 cup flour
1/2 cup butter or oleo
5 Tablespoons Powdered Sugar
Mix completely and press into 9x13 baking pan.
Bake at 350 degrees for 15 minutes

Peach Mixture

Combine the following:
3 cups peaches or nectarines
1 1/2 cup sugar
2 Eggs beaten
1/4 cup flour

Pour peach mixture over the baked crust.
Bake until the fruit is cooked about 30 to 40
Minutes.
