

### *Grilled Chicken Salad with Raspberry Vinaigrette*

*4 Small Boneless Chicken Breasts*

*1/4 c Raspberry Flavored Vinegar*

*1/2 tsp. dried Basil*

*1/4 tsp. Garlic Powder*

*1 Tablespoon Olive Oil*

*1/4 tsp. sugar*

*1/4 tsp. salt*

*8 cups of salad greens*

*1 small can of mandarin oranges drained*

*1/4 cup of dried cranberries*

*1/4 cup slivered almonds*

*Grill chicken breasts on low, turning over until done.*

*Combine the rest of the ingredients in a jar ( stop at*

*the salad greens). Rinse the salad green and drain.*

*In a large bowl, 1st layer is lettuce, 2nd layer is man-  
darin oranges, 3rd sprinkle cranberries, 4th layer is  
slivered almonds, 5th layer is cut up cooked chicken.*

*Top with more Raspberry Vinaigrette just before  
serving. Refrigerate leftovers. Serves 6 persons.*
