

Rose Carlson's Toffee Almond Sandies

1 cup of Butter, no substitutes

1 cup of Vegetable Oil

2 Eggs beaten

1 cup powdered sugar

1 cup of granulated sugar

3 1/2 cup of flour

1 cup whole wheat flour

2 cup finely chopped almonds

1 6 oz. package of toffee bits

1 teaspoon of almond extract

1 tsp. cream of tartar

1 tsp. baking soda

1 tsp. salt

Cream butter, oil, eggs, and sugars. Add flour and cream of tartar and baking soda, and salt gradually. Stir in toffee bits and chopped almonds.

Take a spoonful and roll into a ball in roll in granulated sugar, place on a baking sheet and use a fork and flatten the top. Bake at 350 degrees for 12 to 14 minutes depending on desired color.
