

**Leprechaun Pistachio Cake**  
**Package of White Cake Mix**  
**1 pkg. of 3.4 oz. pistachio instant pudding mix**  
**3 eggs**  
**1 cup water**  
**1/2 cup vegetable oil**  
**1/2 chopped nuts**

**Topping**  
**3.4 oz. pkg. pistachio instant pudding mix**  
**12 oz. container of whipped topping**  
**1 1/2 c milk**

- 1. Combine cake mix, pudding mix, eggs, water, and oil in a large mixing bowl. With an electric mixer, blend ingredients on low speed. Turn to medium for an additional 4 minutes. Fold in chopped nuts.**
- 2. Spoon the batter into a greased and floured 9x13 pan. Bake at 350 degrees for 40 to 45 minutes.**
- 3. Cool cake. Whip together pudding and milk. Fold in container of whipped topping.**
- 4. Frost cake. Refrigerate.**
