

RESOLUTION 2013-56

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING RAIN SENSOR REBATE PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the City of Wayne has adopted a Wellhead Protection Plan to provide base level information and tracking of changes in water quantity and quality in the Wellhead Protection Areas; and

WHEREAS the best use of groundwater is an important goal of wellhead protection for all uses of the aquifer; and

WHEREAS, over-watering of turf is wasteful of the groundwater even when there is an adequate supply.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Wayne, Nebraska, that the City of Wayne will initiate a one-year Rain Sensor Rebate trial period for property owners with automatic lawn sprinkler systems on the municipal water system that will provide a maximum \$75.00 incentive, with a cap of \$1,500.00 per year, to install and operate an automatic rain sensor system. The purpose of the rain sensor system would be to sense the amount of rain received and cut out the pre-set automatic watering cycles following that rain to avoid excessive watering.
