**Crust: 1/2 cup Soft Butter**  
**1/4 cup Brown Sugar**  
**1 1/2 cup Rice Krispies**  
**1/2 cup Chopped Nuts**

**Pat into 7 1/2 in. x 9 in pan or 2 pie pans**  
**Chill.**

**Filling mix : 1 cup canned pumpkin,**  
**1/2 cup Sugar**  
**1/2 tsp. Salt**  
**1/2 tsp. Nutmeg or Pumpkin Pie Spice**  
**1 Quart Soft Vanilla Ice Cream**
