An atmosphere that bids me feel worthwhile.*


*The light of love upon its cheerful face,



Mardi Gras King's Cake

1 pound frozen bread dough
12 ounces pkg. cream cheese
1 1/2 cup powdered sugar
1 sm package of instant lemon pudding (dry)
1 tiny baby (nestle baby underneath done cake.

Frosting

1 2/3 cups powdered sugar
6 tbsp. milk
1 tsp. vanilla extract
2 tablespoon butter
Purple, Green, Gold, Red Sprinkles
1. Thaw the bread dough & roll out on a floured surface into a rectangular shape.
2. Mix the cream cheese, powdered sugar, & lemon pudding (dry). Spread on dough.
3. Roll up like a jellyroll.. Brush with butter. Let rise. Bake 350 deg. 30 to 35 min.
