## **French Silk Pie**

**"For the Chocolate Lover"**

**1 sheet refrigerated pie pastry (Pricked & Baked)**

**2/3 cup sugar**

**2 squares (1 ounce each )**

**unsweetened chocolate, melted**

**1 teaspoon vanilla**

**1/3 cup butter, softened**

**2/3 cup heavy whipped cream**

**2 teaspoons confectioners sugar**

**1/3 cup heavy whipping cream**

**Put pastry into pie pan, and follow instructions.**

**In a small saucepan, combine sugar and eggs until well blended, cook on low and stir until mixture coats the pan, turn off heat- Add chocolate and vanilla and stir. Cool. In a small mixing bowl, cream butter until light and fluffy. Add egg mixture and stir. In 2nd mixing bowl beat 1 c. cream until whipped ,add confectioners sugar. Save 1/3cup for garnish. Fold in the remainder whipped cream to chocolate mixture.**

**Pour into crust. Cool. Garnish. Enjoy.**
