



- Dad Chocolate Angel Cake Dessert*
- 1 (6 oz.) pkg. chocolate chips*
  - 2 Tbsp. water*
  - 1 Tbsp. sugar*
  - 4 Eggs, separated*
  - 2 Cups Cool Whip*
  - 1 loaf Angel Food Cake*

*Melt chocolate chips in double boiler. Gradually add 4 egg yolks which have been well beaten with 2 Tbs. water and 1 Tbs. sugar. Cook until yolks are done.*

*Cool.*  
*Fold in 4 stiffly beaten egg whites and Cool Whip. Butter a 9 x 13 inch pan. Tear cake into bite sized pieces and place in pan. Pour chocolate mixture over and toss lightly. Chill and frost with extra Cool Whip*


