Mom’s Coconut Cream Pie

1/2 cup sugar
1/3 cup cornstarch
1/3 teaspoon salt
2 cups milk
3 beaten egg yolks (save whites for meringue)
2 Tablespoons butter
1 cup flaked coconut, divided
1 teaspoon vanilla
1/4 teaspoon almond flavoring
1 9 inch baked pie shell
Combine sugar, cornstarch, salt, milk and egg yolk.
Cook until thick. Remove from heat and add butter, coconut and vanilla and almond flavoring.
Cool. Pour into the baked pie shell.

Meringue-
Combine 3 egg whites, and 6 tablespoons sugar.
Beat until stiff peaks form, spread over filling, sealing the edge.
Sprinkle 1/2 cup coconut on meringue.
Bake pie at 350 degrees for 10 to 15 minutes to Golden brown. Cool pie before cutting. Serves 8.
