

RESOLUTION NO. 2009-69

A RESOLUTION FOR NATIONAL FUNCTIONAL CLASSIFICATION REVISION.

WHEREAS, a system of functionally classified streets has been established in the Wayne urban area; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Wayne City Council to revise the existing system of functionally classified streets in order to meet the following changing traffic conditions.

Road segments 1 and 2, described below, now carry traffic to and from the following businesses on or near Centennial Road: a truck trailer factory; a manufactured home factory; a ready-mix concrete plant; 2 agricultural chemical suppliers; 2 farm implement dealers; a repair shop; a truck stop. The traffic to and from these businesses includes a lot of trucks and farm equipment as well as the vehicles of commuting employees.

Road segments 1 and 2 are also the main route by which trucks haul sand and gravel to the ready-mix concrete plant. Moreover, a lot of trucks on Nebraska Highways 35 and 15 use road segments 1 and 2 as an unofficial bypass around Wayne. Such traffic increased considerably after Wayne County built a new bridge just north of road segment 1 in 1988.

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Wayne City Council that the following revisions to the National Functional Classification be submitted to the Federal Highway Administration for approval:

The following described road segments 1 and 2 shall be classified as Rural Major Collectors:

1. That part of Centennial Road with the following described centerline:

Beginning at the Southeast corner of Section 18, Township 26 North, Range 4 East, thence north on the east line of said Section 18 to the south bank of South Logan Creek.

2. That part of 855th Road with the following described centerline:

Beginning at the Southeast corner of Section 18, Township 26 North, Range 4 East, thence west on the south line of said Section 18 to the southwest corner thereof.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of these facts, the City Council takes the following official action:

BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The Nebraska Department of Roads is hereby requested to prepare the necessary documents and take all necessary steps required in order to obtain the approval of the above-described revisions to the National Functional Classification System in the Wayne Urban Area.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT:

Said Wayne City Council hereby expresses its agreement with and support of a similar resolution to be adopted by the Wayne County Board of Commissioners requesting reclassification of a certain road segment connected to the above-described road segments 1 and 2.
