Pina Colada Pie

3 Eggs Slightly Beaten

1/2 Sugar

4 Tablespoons Flour

1/8 tsp. salt

Mix These 4 Ingredients Together. Then add:

1 cup light corn syrup

1 tsp. vanilla

1 1/2 cup crushed pineapple + juice

1 cup coconut

Combine all ingredients together and pour into:
1 unbaked pie crust

Drizzle 1/4 cup melted butter over the top.

Bake at 400 degrees for 15 minutes.

Then bake at 350 degrees until done (about 30 min)

Or until golden brown consistently on top.

Great with vanilla ice cream or whipped topping.
