

March's Mandarin Squares

Recipe comes from the Plum Thicket in Grand Island
Serves 30

***2 tubes Ritz crackers
1/2 cup melted margarine
1/2 cup sugar
1 tube frozen orange juice concentrate
2 smaller cans mandarin oranges, drained
8 oz whipped topping
1 can sweetened condensed milk
1 small can pineapple tidbits, drained***

***Combine crushed crackers, margarine and sugar.
Use half to 3/4's of mixture to line bottom of un-
greased 9 x 13 inch dish. Set aside the remaining
Crumbs.***

***In a large bowl, combine sweetened condensed milk
and orange juice concentrate. Mix well. Add orang-
es, pineapple, and whipped topping. Pour mixture
over the crust and spread evenly with spatula.
Sprinkle with remaining crumbs and refrigerate .***
