





Crunchy Festive Tossed Salad

6 cups torn salad greens

2 green onions, chopped

1 cup chow mein noodles

1/2 cup chopped cashews or slivered almonds

3 Tbsp. Crumbled Cooked Bacon

2 Tablespoons Sesame Seeds

1/2 c. Mandarin Oranges

1/8 c. Dried Cranberry Bits

Salad Dressing of your Choice Just Before Serving
Combine and Toss Just before Serving. 4-6 Servings.
