The Energy Policy Act of 2005 extended the period of Daylight Saving Time. Standard Time in each zone (in most places in the U.S. and Canada) is advanced one hour from 2 a.m. on the second Sunday in March until 2 a.m. on the first Sunday in November .

Check Your Batteries Day

This day is held annually when Daylight Saving Time begins, now the second Sunday in March, as a time to check/change batteries in smoke detectors, carbon monoxide detectors, and other electronic devices.
