

**MINUTES**  
**CITY COUNCIL MEETING**  
**August 25, 2020**

The Wayne City Council met in special session in the 1912 Emporium Building, 117 W. 2<sup>nd</sup> Street, on August 25, 2020, at 5:30 o'clock P.M.

Mayor Cale Giese called the meeting to order with the following in attendance: Councilmembers Dwaine Spieker, Terri Buck, Jennifer Sievers, Jason Karsky, Matt Eischeid and Jill Brodersen; Attorney Amy Miller; City Administrator Wes Blecke; and City Clerk Betty McGuire. Absent: Councilmembers Jon Haase and Chris Woehler.

Notice of the convening meeting was given in advance by posting in three places on August 21, 2020, and a copy of the meeting notice was simultaneously given to the Mayor and all members of the City Council. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the Council convened in open session.

Mayor Giese advised the public that a copy of the Open Meetings Act was located on the east wall of the 1912 Emporium Building, as well as on the City of Wayne website at [cityofwayne.org/8/Government](http://cityofwayne.org/8/Government), and was available for public inspection. In addition, he advised the public that the Council may go into closed session to discuss certain agenda items to protect the public interest or to prevent the needless injury to the reputation of an individual and if such individual has not requested a public hearing.

The meeting was then turned over to Luke Virgil, Executive Director of Wayne Area Economic Development, for the "Wayne Partners" meeting.

Introductions were made and then each table had "small" group discussions concerning the 2019 Visioning Session Report. Feedback was given by each table. Mr. Virgil and staff would review the feedback and update the information provided. The intent is for this group to meet again in 6 months.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, the meeting was adjourned at or about 7:00 p.m.
