

Accepted Batteries: Alkaline, NiMH, NiCd, Heavy Duty, Non-Lithium Button Cell, Small Household Lithium & Lithium-ion

Taping Battery Terminals: The terminals, or exposed metal parts of certain batteries can rub together creating a spark. It only takes one to start a fire! Proper taping ensures safe storage and transit.

No Tape Required

But if in doubt, go ahead and use CLEAR tape.



Nickel Metal Hydride (NiMH) or Nickel Cadmium (NiCd), less than 9 volts



Alkaline



"Heavy Duty" Zinc Carbon



Non-Lithium Button Cell



Tape Required

Tape ALL terminals with a piece of CLEAR tape before putting them in the container.



ALL Lithium & Lithium-ion with exposed terminals



DO NOT put plastic bags of batteries in the recycling bucket. Remove from bags first and follow taping guidelines. However, do place corroded alkaline batteries in a clear ziplock bag to avoid creating a spark. Do not combine these batteries with any others.

NOT Accepted: Large, heavy batteries such as lead acid, electronic batteries and batteries over 9 volts
