

# Waste Connections Curbside Recycling Service in Wayne, NE

## How Do I Recycle?



*All items must be empty, rinsed, and clean of any food or liquid to avoid contamination. Place loose in the recycle container.*

### Aluminum and Tin

#### Examples of what is accepted:

- Fruit & vegetable cans
- Beverage cans
- Food Spray in a can (Pam)
- Foil and foil pans/trays
- Metal lids from glass jars and bottles
- Pet food tins
- Coffee cans
- Hairspray cans



*To avoid injury to your collector, please place lids from cans inside the can and pinch the top of the can to trap the lid inside. Labels left on is OK*

### Plastics

#### Examples of what is accepted:

- Pop bottles
- Juice bottles
- Milk jugs
- Clamshell containers (such as for berries, salad)
- Clear and Colored Plastics with #1,2,3,4,5,6 and 7 stamped on the bottom of the container
- Household cleaning bottles
- Shampoo bottles
- Detergent bottles
- Pill bottles



*Lids can be on or off. No plastic bags, nozzles, or Styrofoam of any kind. **No plastic flower pots.***

### Paper and Newspaper

#### Examples of what is accepted:

- Brown paper sacks
- Newspaper
- Magazines
- Wrapping paper
- White office paper
- Computer paper
- Junk mail
- Mixed paper (construction ok)



# Cardboard

## Examples of what is accepted:

- Corrugated cardboard
- Toy boxes
- Waxed food cartons
- Shoe boxes
- Toilet paper & paper towel rolls
- Pop and beer boxes
- Detergent boxes
- Tissue boxes
- Cereal boxes



Cardboard boxes must be **flattened and clean**. All Styrofoam and plastic liners, tissue, inserts, wrappings and staples must be removed from cardboard and is **garbage**. **No grease or food stains, such as on pizza boxes.**

# Items We Do Not Accept

**Glass** • recycle at Wayne Transfer Station

**Plastic Bags** • recycle at Wayne grocery stores

## Metal:

- Pie plates
- License plates
- Batteries
- Paint cans
- Coat hangers
- Cooking pots and pans

## Miscellaneous:

- Styrofoam
- Wicker/Wood
- Containers used for chewing tobacco
- Bubble wrap
- Food items
- Medical Waste
- Kleenex
- Oil jugs
- Diapers
- Feminine products
- Any unmarked plastics

**Hazardous Materials:** No hazardous materials of any kind.

## More Info

**Waste Connections** reserves the right to refuse any recyclables if contaminated or unacceptable. Refused recyclables will be disposed of in the garbage truck.

- Wash out all food and beverage containers. Even one dirty item contaminates the whole load.
- Boxes need to be flattened to save room in the truck.
